

Day 1: Saturday, October 4:

in Athens. Next day drive to Cape Sounio, known for its Temple of Poseidon, one of the major monuments of the Golden Age of Athens. Its remains are perched on the headland, surrounded on three sides by the Aegean sea. Wine tasting in Spata. Greek folk dancing. Overnight Electra Rhythm hotel in Athens.









Day 4: Tuesday, October 7

See **Corinthian canal**, archaeological site of **Mycenae**, theater at **Epidaurus**. Dinners, **folk dancing**. overnight in Nauplion at Amelia Hotel.

Day 5: Wednesday, October 8:

This morning visit the Palamidi fortress and the ouzo distillery, or Nemea and a winery nearby. Dinner and overnight in Nauplion. (B, D)



Day 6: Thursday, October 9: Nauplion-Olympia

The morning tour to explore Peloponnese. Visit Olympia. Dinner and overnight in Olympia. (B, D)

Day 7: Friday, October 10: Olympia-Delphi

Drive through Nafpakto. Visit the archeological sites of Delphi. Dinner, folk dancing, Overnight in Fedriades hotel. (B, D)

Day 8: Saturday, October 11: Morning visit to **Delphi museum.** Drive through **Arachova, Lamia, and Trikala.** Arrive in Kalambaka. Dinner, **folk dancing**, Overnight in Kalambaka: Amalia hotel.

Day 9: Sunday, October 12: Visit breathtaking cliff monasteries of Meteora. Rising from gigantic rocks, they appear as nature's gift to the pious who chose solitude and a life of worship. Lunch and Greek folk dancing in a local Kastraki restaurant.

Return to Athens, passing through historic **Thermopyle.** Overnight Electra Rhythm hotel in Athens.



Lee Otterholt, born in USA of Norwegian-American parents, has lived and worked in Norway as a professional dancer, teacher, and choreographer. He founded the Center for International Folk Dance in Oslo, and was professor of dance folklore at the Norwegian National College of Ballet, and University College of Oslo. Lee established folk dance and performing groups in Norway, taught at festivals and workshops throughout Europe, United States, and East Asia, and authored folk dance and instructional manuals for Norwegian schools. He was a choreographer for the Opening Ceremony of the Winter Olympic Games in Lillehammer.

Air Transportation: International air not included except as noted.

Rates: Tour rates are subject to change in the event of currency fluctuations or increase in costs. Inclusive tour rates are per person in double occupancy. In case of computer or human billing errors, we reserve the right to reinvoice clients with corrected billing.

Reservations: Deposits and Payments: Deposit of \$200 per person is required at time of reservation. Balance is due 90 days prior to departure date.

Changes: Prices and program subject to change without notice

Baggage: One baggage per person and a carry on is allowed.
